The results of CBSE examination 2023 prove that our students excel in their performance in class X and XII. Their performance was really commendable. We achieved 100% results in all subjects. **Anantha Narayan. B** was the top scorer. He scored 562 out of 600 marks. The result of class XII was also outstanding. The top scorer of class XII was **Sivabala. R**. Nair. She scored 445 marks out of 500 in the commerce stream and from the commerce stream and **M.V Lekshmi Priya** scored 431 marks out of 500.

TEACHERS TRAINING PROGRAMMES
